Adopted Special City Council Meeting Minutes**

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kuehn called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

III. CITY BUSINESS ACTION ITEMS & RECOMMENDATIONS

A. Canvassing of the 2018 Municipal Election Results

- Minnesota State Statute 205.185 requires cities to certify and declare the election results between three (3) and 10 days following the election.
- The City Council acts as the Canvassing Board.
- There was one (1) Mayoral seat on the 2018 ballot.
- There were two (2) City Council seats on the 2018 ballot.
- Candidate Terry Furlong ran uncontested for the Mayoral seat.
- Candidates for municipal office were: City Council – Tim Cole, Scott Thorsen, Candy Petersen, Chris Johnson and Ronnie Sprigler.
- North St. Paul had 7,068 registered voters as of 7 a.m. on November 6, 2018.
- The certified results were provided to the City by Ramsey County on Tuesday, November 13, 2018 and are as follows:
 - Terry Furlong: 4,244 votes and 144 write-ins.
 - Tim Cole: 1,663 votes
 - Scott Thorsen: 1,856 votes
 - Candy Petersen: 2,487 votes
 - Chris Johnson: 978 votes
 - Ronnie Sprigler: 490 votes
 - Write-Ins: 47 votes

On motion by Council Member Furlong, seconded by Council Member Sonnek, with all present voting aye (5-0), motion carried to adopt Resolution No. 2018-140 certifying that the following persons are hereby declared to be elected to four-year terms for the following municipal offices commencing January 7, 2019 and expiring on December 31, 2022, following the official administration of the Oath of Office:
